Job Description

Clinical Midwife

- Delivers patients' babies in either birthing centers or hospital settings.
- Provides emotional support and guidance before, during, and after labor.
- Taking and recording patients' vital signs and requesting diagnostic tests as needed.
- Performs internal examination to assess cervical dilatation, effacement, fetal presentation, and bag of water.
- Monitors progress of labor and fetal heart rate.
- Reports any abnormalities in the patient's condition to the physician that needs immediate medical attention.
- Repairs perineal laceration up to the second degree.
- Insert intravenous fluid if indicated and gives oxytocin intramuscularly.
- Performs cord care which includes anthropometric measurements, administration of vitamin k, and eye ointment.
- Assists new mothers how to feed their newborns.
- Accomplishes patient's chart.
- Do after care.

Community Midwife

- Identifies high-risk pregnancies and educates patients and their families on antenatal care and reproductive health.
- Provides direct prenatal, intrapartum, postpartum, and or well-women patient services and primary care to-low-moderate risk obstetrical and gynecological patients.
- Assisting patients in creating suitable birth plans.
- Provides sound advice to patients regarding diets, exercises, and medications suitable for pregnancy.
- Helps patients and their partners to cope with miscarriages, stillbirths, neonatal deaths, and terminations.
- Conducts house-to-house health education and awareness campaigns for reproductive health and health maintenance.
- Reports status of families/households visited especially the pregnant and post-partum mothers.
- Facilitate community participation in the implementation and monitoring of programs and projects of the Department of Health.
- Develops Barangay Health Plans.
- Maintains referral system for difficult/complicated pregnancies.
- Mans the Barangay Health Station.
- Participate in data gathering and responsiveness during health emergencies and disasters.
- Provides quality health care services to the community, especially to those who are located in Geodetically Isolated and Disadvantage Areas (GIDA).
- Conduct Routine Immunization for infants, children, and women.
- Conduct Defaulter Tracing for those who did not completed their immunization.
