- Conduct chemical analyses of body fluids, such as blood and urine, using microscope or automatic analyzer to detect abnormalities or diseases, and enter findings into computer whenever required.
- Set up, adjust, maintain, and clean medical laboratory equipment.
- Conduct blood tests for transfusion purposes and perform blood counts (for Hematology unit staff).
- Obtain specimens, cultivating, isolating and identifying microorganisms for analysis and inoculate broths, or other bacteriological media with organisms (for Microbiology unit staff);
- Collect blood or tissue samples from patients, observing principles of asepsis to obtain blood sample (for Phlebotomy unit staff).
- Maintain regular sufficient inventory of material supplies and equipment for performance of duties as directed by Unit Head.
- Maintain all test results are performed within its assigned TAT through continuous worklist follow-up as directed by Unit Head. And deal upon cases with extended TAT.
- Maintain working area clean and temperature monitoring as required for assigned unit.
