COMMON COMPETENCIES:

- **Prepare the Animal/Shower the Animal Stunning Box/Restraining Box-Animal** is placed/driven inside the stunning box for proper restrain observe animal welfare.
- **STUNNING** – Use the electric stunner to stun the animal application of stunner on the forehead for 10 seconds or more.
- **SHACKLING** – shackle the animal at the hock joint assuring the chain is properly lock at the hock point.
- **LIFTING** – with the use of power hoist or elevator animal raised at proper level to execute sticking.
- **SCALDING** – Nimal is lowered to the scalding vat to loosen the hair for effective dehairing.
- **DEHAIRING** – Animal is transferred to the dehairing machine for proper dehairing.
- **SECONDARY DEHAIRING** – Manually done to remove left over hairs.
- **GAMBRELLING** – Gambrel-hanger in form and in place at the hind feet after exposing the tendom.
- **OPEN CHEST BONE/OPEN PELVIC BONE RING AND TIE BUNG REMOVE HOOVES** – Cutting the sternum at the middle to free the esophagus and wind pipe. Tying of bug with use of straw to secure and avoid fouling.
- **SINGEING** – with the use of blow torch (LPG) to burn fine hairs.
- **EVISCARATION/REMOVE SEX ORGAN** – Removing sex organ if male prior to removal of internal organs (inverted knife stroke)
- **PRESENT OFFAL FOR INSPECTION** - Offal's should be properly presented to meat inspector or veterinarians for post-mortem inspection. Separate red and white offal's.
- **SPLITTING** – with the use of circular saw carcass is cut into halves (Sagittaly) Starting from the coccygeal bone down to cervical bone.
- **WASHING/TRIMMING** – Carcass is washed properly to remove dirt such as bone dust, blood, dirt, trimming of hematoma, cyst, dirt in the carcass.
- **GRADING/BRANDING** – Grading of carcass thru back fat thickness.
